 - A. This service was brought to Senate's attention by Hannah Godbout from the Counseling Center. This would be a one-year trial run. From Hannah:
 1. In short, the Counseling Center for multiple years now has been trying to secure the funds to purchase a 24/7/365 add-on behavioral health service called Protocall. Many campuses in Minnesota already use this service, they are becoming almost standard practice for college counseling centers. I have attached their proposal below, for anyone from the Senate to view as needed. We would love to have this service on our campus, at minimum, trialing it for the 2021-2022 academic year. You will see in the proposal that the cost is \$1500 a month and \$2500 one-time set up fee- this amounts to a total of \$20,500 for a year. We have been pursuing additional potential funding sources, and could potentially come up with \$5,000-\$10,000 through other channels, in an ideal world the Senate could also offer \$10,000 to get us to our total. It has been made clear to me over the past few years how concerned the students on our campus and of course our Student Senate are about mental health resources on our campus. This would be a concrete way to significantly increase availability of these services, any time of day, any day of the year.
